Dear Residents and Business Owners,

On August 12, 2013, City Council made a motion to pursue a Federal Emergency Management Agency Grant to elevate homes that qualify for funding. Based on the loss data provided by the National Flood Insurance Program your property may qualify for funding through FEMA to be elevated. In order to better determine if the benefits outweigh the costs for each property, an Elevation Certificate must be obtained. The City has hired a consultant to complete the Elevation Certificate for each of the homes included in the study at no cost to the homeowners. You may notice surveyors on your property collecting data points to complete the certificates over the next couple of weeks.

Once the Elevation Certificates are completed and the initial study is completed to determine if your home/business qualifies for federal funding for elevation, the City will provide additional information to you in regards to the grant process and what the home elevation process entails. You should receive this information in early October.
